Live Mice

Live animals in the classroom can become a captivating experience for all involved. To ensure success we recommend a few precautions.

Mice like to be warm and can go into shock, and even die, if the temperature varies significantly. They are coming to you from an environment that has been thermostatically maintained at 21-22°C and although this is not always possible in the classroom environment, a few simple precautions will reduce the potential for casualties.

At many times during the year, the classroom temperature can go very low overnight. To safe guard against the impact of this, we recommend that you give your mice plenty of bedding material. Timber shaving, paper or cotton wool work very well. Some bedding materials can be occasionally deleterious to the health of mice, but the chances of losing them to cold weather are far more significant. Body heat loss can also be minimised by placing an inverted margarine container, with small access holes cut into it, on the bottom of the cage. This forms a “house” and offers extra protection.

Like all animals, mice like a proper diet. Mouse pellets are recommended, thereby maintaining their feeding pattern and reducing illness and death.

A word of warning:

Male mice should be separated on arrival. They will fight each other viciously if left together in the same cage.

Cage Deposits:

The cage deposit charge on your invoice is fully refundable on return of the cage within two weeks of invoice date. Obviously the expectation is that the cage is in the same condition as when despatch to you. If your return is outside the two week time -frame a fee will apply.

Cages should be returned to our postal address (not via rail). All cost associated with the return is to be covered by you the client.

When returning, please ensure that the wire top is FIRMLY secured to the plastic base.
